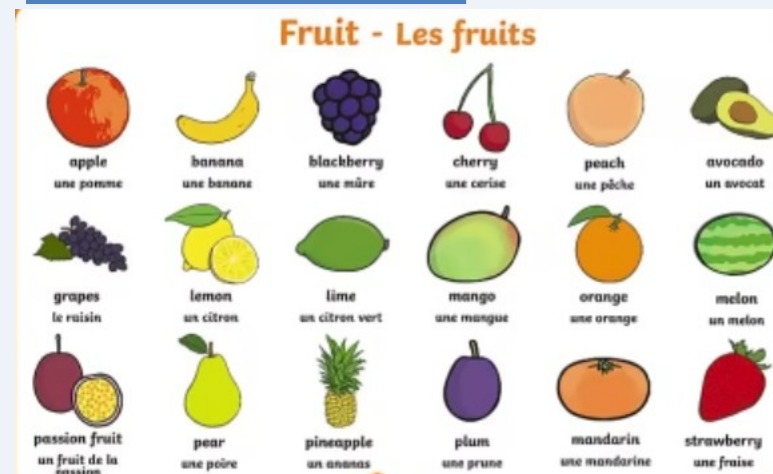

### Areas in France

**Paris** (nicknamed the "City of light") is the capital city of France, and the largest city in France. The area is 105 km<sup>2</sup>, and around 2.15 million people live there.

The Seine river runs through the oldest part of Paris, and divides it into two parts, known as the Left Bank and the Right Bank. Paris has many art museums and historical buildings. It has a very good underground subway system called the *Metro*. The *Metro* was built in 1900, and its total length is more than 200 km.
