Values	Something that is important in terms of what you believe or how you act.
Authority	Having power over something or someone.
Non-religious	Not believing in a religion.

Humanist

A person who seeks natural explanations to answer life's big questions and for events in the world

Humanism

A non-religious worldview of life and the world.

Key knowledge to know and use

- Everybody in the world has their own personal worldview and this can be religious or non-religious .
- All worldviews have different moral ways of living and this affects how people treat other people and the world around them.
- A Christian will have values which are based on the life of Jesus and the teachings of the Christian Church .
- People who hold Humanism as a world view will have the belief that they should be free to work out for themselves what makes us happy and that we should be kind to the planet and animals.
