Luke, Matthew and Mark	The three gospels which are similar in the New Testament (Bible).
parables	A story Jesus told that had a special meaning.
commandments	A rule which has to be observed.
interpretation	A way of explaining one meaning of something.
leprosy	An illness, a bacterial infection.
Christ-like	Becoming more like Jesus in how people act.

Gospel

This literally means 'Good news' but also the title of the four books of the Bible that tell the story of the life of Jesus.

Theology

The study of God and religious belief or a set of beliefs.

Key knowledge to know and use

- The gospels contain the parables that Jesus told and how he told people to live known as commandments.
- The gospels contain the two great commandments of Jesus that tell Christians how to live.
- He also gave The Sermon on the Mount to tell people how to live.
- Jesus would show that the good news was for everyone including those people in society many did not like. An example of this was Jesus healing people with leprosy, a disease that people were scared of.
