Year 6 – Why do Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah?



Key vocabulary to remember and use in your learning

Word	Definition
Messiah	A saviour from God promised in the Hebrew texts
Saviour	Someone who saves or rescues people
Immanuel	A Hebrew name meaning God is with us
Theological	The study of God and religious belief
Prophecy	A prediction of what will happen in the future
Gospel	The good news about Jesus, a book in the New Testament recounting Jesus' life

Prophet

A prophet is a person who speaks God's truth to others. In the Bible, the prophets Micah and Isaiah speak of a messiah who be sent by God to heal the damage done by people's disobedience.

Incarnation

Means 'in the flesh'; Christians believe Jesus is God in the flesh or God incarnate.

Key knowledge to know and use

- When Adam and Eve disobeyed God in the Garden of Eden they were sent away from God. This is known as The Fall.
- In the Old Testament there is a prophecy that God will send a Messiah to bring people back to him.
- Christians say this saviour is Jesus, who is God in human form which is a belief they call the incarnation.
