We visited France in Year 1. We learnt how to count in French, how to say hello and goodbye and most importantly tasted some delicious treats!



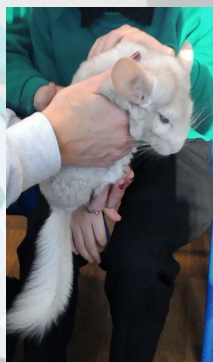
Y1 Trip to Conisbrough Castle
