



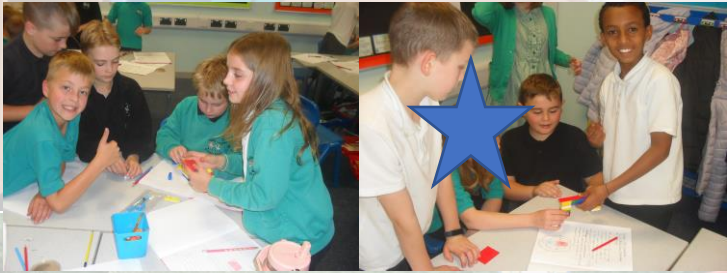
# Abbey Lane Primary School

Thank you to parents/carers for attending our Badminton Showcase at Abbeydale Road – we have loved our PE lessons this term.



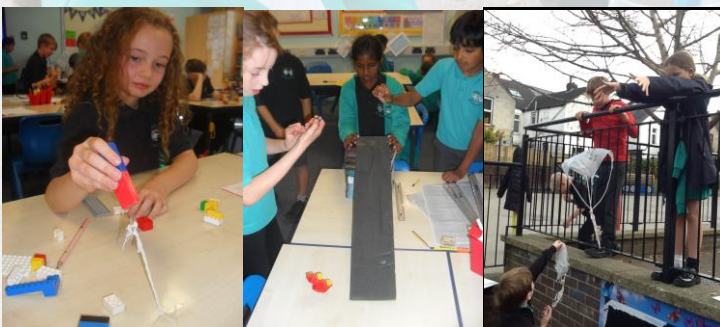
We thoroughly enjoyed our Art lessons this term – clay sculpting was great fun!
