

FS2 Overview- Summer 1- Yummy Food!

This term we will be looking at building constructive and respectful relationships. We will be exploring our own feelings and showing sensitivity to the feelings of others. We will be looking at healthy lifestyles and the importance of healthy food choices. We will also look at oral hygiene. In continuous provision we will confidently try new activities and show independence, resilience and perseverance.

Communication and Language

This term we will be developing our communication and language skills using a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to food. We will be joining in whole class discussions and asking questions to clarify our understanding. We will confidently express our thoughts and feelings when speaking in small group and class discussions.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on numbers beyond 10, building these numbers and looking at counting patterns. We will be looking at addition and subtraction with numbers within 10. We will look at number patterns and shapes.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be moving to music and expressing ourselves through Dance. We will continue to build up our repertoire of songs and poems. In Music sessions we will listen to music from different countries and use instruments to explore duration. In continuous provision we will be developing our colour mixing and collage skills.

Physical Development

This term in P.E. we will be developing our co-ordination, agility and spatial awareness through Games and Dance. We will continue to develop our gross motor skills exploring the equipment in continuous provision and experimenting with different ways of moving. We will be developing our fine motor skills using a range of tools with increased control and precision. We will continue with our handwriting sessions focussing on correct letter formation.

Literacy

This term we will be listening to stories about food. We will be using non-fiction books to find out about different foods and countries. We will continue with our daily Little Wandle Phonics sessions, focussing on Phase 4. We will use our developing skills to write, captions and simple sentences and will read our work back to check it makes sense. We will be developing our reading and comprehension skills through our weekly reading sessions.

Understanding of the World

This term we will be learning all about which places are special for Muslims and Christians. We will continue to look at seasonal change and the effects on the natural world. We will be looking at food from around the world, using maps to locate different places. We will also be observing and discussing changes that occur when cooking and baking.
