Place of Interest– Eiffel Tower

The Eiffel Tower (in French: la tour d'Eiffel) is one of the landmarks most people can easily link to France. The metal construction stands in the city centre of Paris and was built in 1889 as a centrepiece for the World's Fair. It was meant to be there only for the exhibition, but it still is the main attraction in France's capital city.
