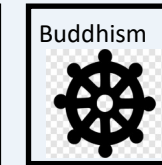
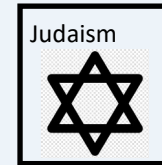
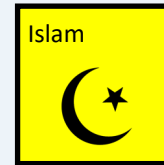

A Vicar



A Vicar works in a Church and holds religious services such as marriages and christenings. They are an important part of the religious community.

An Imam

An Imam is the worship leader in a Mosque. They lead religious services, give people advice and are an important part of the Islamic community.



Key knowledge to know and use

- The place of worship for Christians is called a Church and the place of worship for Muslims is a Mosque.
- The cross is a very important symbol in Christianity because it represents Jesus.
- Islam is represented by a crescent moon and a star, this represents progress and knowledge.
