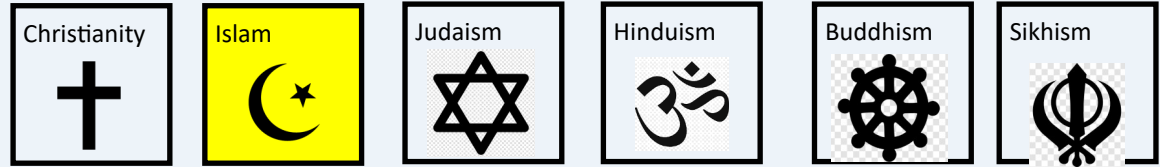

Mecca	Is a city in Saudi Arabia, it is where the prophet Muhammad was born and all Muslims pray towards Mecca.
Kaaba	A small stone building in the court of the great Mosque at Mecca. It has a sacred black stone inside.
Hijab	A head cover worn by some Muslim women.

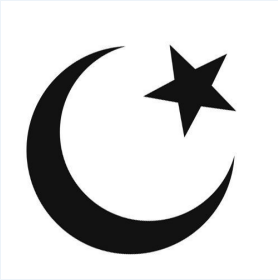


### The Madina Masjid

Do you recognise this Mosque? The Madina Masjid is the first purpose built Mosque in Sheffield. It was finished in 2006 and has 19 rooms, 2 large halls, a library and a day centre inside!

### Salat

Salat is the second pillar of Islam. Salat is the practise of praying five times a day! It is very important in the Islamic religion.
