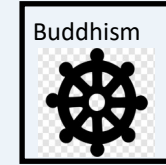
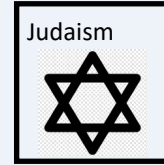
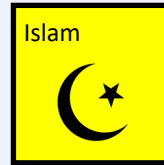

Brahma	The creator God in Hinduism.

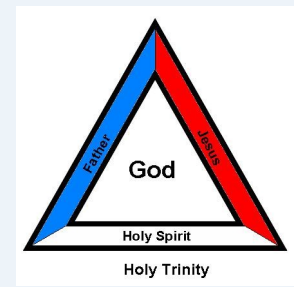
Reincarnation
