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## The prophet Muhammed

The prophet Muhammed was a merchant born in Mecca. He was respected as he was a wise and fair business man. Muslims believe that he was chosen by Allah to be his prophet (inspiring teacher of the will of God/Allah) as he was kind and fair, also because he was concerned for the people.

### <u>Jacob</u>

Jacob is known as a leader of Islam. He is recognised as an ancestor through which many prophets and saints came including Moses and Muhammed.
