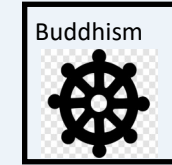
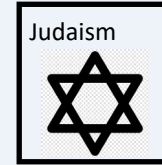
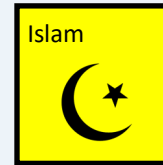

A Christian charity which helps people around the world. They help communities overcome poverty and disasters. They also work alongside local churches and organisations to help people build better futures.

An International aid and development charity helping the needy around the world.
