information	Information is things that you know.
data	Data is information that is in numbers, like how old you are or the number of pupils in class.
chart	A chart, or graph, is a picture that shows information and makes it easy to understand.
pictogram	A chart that uses pictures to show data.
photograph	A picture that is taken with a camera.
digital camera	A digital camera takes a photograph and then it can be put on a computer or phone and sent to different people.
focus	Whether a photograph is easy to see or not.
close-up	A photograph that shows something up close.

- Data can be presented in different charts.
- A pictogram is a way of showing data—they have axes, a scale, pictures to represent numbers and a key.
- Data can by classified, which means sorting items into similar groups and naming them.
- Venn diagrams can also be used to present information.
- You can use a camera to create images (pictures).
- Personal information is information that is about you.
