Areas in France

Lourdes is a town and commune in the southwest of the Hautes-Pyrénées department. It is in the first Pyrenean foothills, in south western France.

Lourdes was originally a small unremarkable market town lying in the foothills of the Pyrenees. At that time the most prominent feature was the fortified castle which rises up from the centre of the town on a rock. Following the claims that there were apparitions of Lourdes to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858, Lourdes has developed into a major place of Christian pilgrimage.
