Samsara

In Hinduism, Samsara is the name for reincarnation. The cycle of Samsara is the soul being re-born into another living thing. This cycle repeats until Moksha is achieved.



Moksha

This is the goal of Hinduism- the term 'Moksha' means freedom. It means that a soul is free and does not have to keep going through the reincarnation cycle anymore. Having good karma and living a good life can help you to achieve Moksha.
