Ramadan

The ninth month of the Muslim year. Strict fasting takes place during Ramadan from dawn until sunset. Lots of prayer and reflection takes places during Ramadan.

Zakat

One of the Five Pillars of Islam. Zakat is the practise of giving to the poor in Islam.

Muslims believe that it will help to create balance in society by helping those in need.



Key knowledge to know and use

- Baptism is a way for Christians to show devotion to their faith.
- Fasting during Ramadan is an example of Muslim sacrifice
- Jewish people show their devotion by praying 3 times a day. Also through special celebrations such as Passover, Hanukah and Bar/Bat Mitzvahs.
