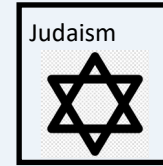
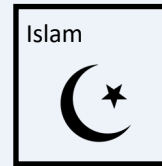

Pilgrimage	A spiritual and religious journey.
Puja	Buddhist worship.
Ghoonghat	A head covering worn by some married Hindu women.
Tripitaka	The Holy Book for Buddhists.
Sanskrit	The ancient language of Hinduism .
Mantra	A word, syllable, phrase or prayer that is repeated over



Hymns

A religious song or poem of praise to God or a God. People often sing these as a group, it helps them feel like they belong to their religion. There are many different Hymns for different occasions and events.

The Vedas

The most ancient sacred texts of the Hindu religion. They are written in Sanskrit. The Vedas scriptures guide Hindus in their daily life.



Key knowledge to know and use

- Collective worship is a way that followers of religion can gain a sense of belonging.
- All Buddhist temples contain an image/statue of Buddha.
- When inside a Buddhist temple, shoes must be worn, simple/comfy clothing and your shoulders and legs should be covered.
- Hindu women will often wear a sari and can wear a head covering (Ghoonghat).
