Repeating Patterns

Key knowledge to know and use

Printing involves moving a mark or picture from one material to another,. This makes a copy of the mark or picture. In most cases, it makes it possible to reproduce a mark or picture more than once. You could paint your hand, press it down on paper and you'd see a copy of your handprint.

Artists use lots of different materials to print designs. You could use items from around the house, such as a sponge, a leaf or even a potato!

Prints can be made using lots of different colours and shapes. Some of these colours and shapes could be overlapped to create different patterns.
