darken	To make a colour dark or darker
lighten	To make a colour light or lighter
mix	Combine or put together
primary colour	A group of colours from which all other colours can be made.
secondary colour	A colour resulting from the mix of 2 primary colours

Primary Colours

The three primary colours are: red, yellow, and blue

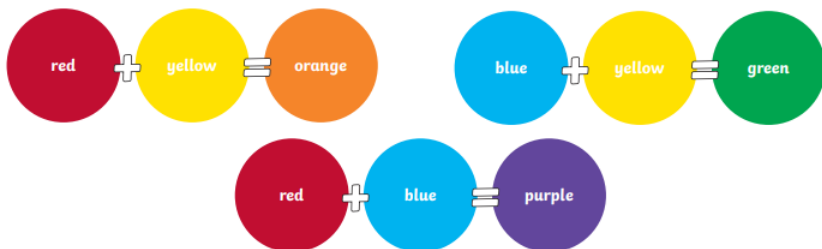


Secondary Colours

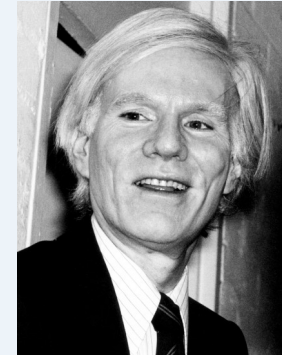
The three secondary colours are: green, orange, and purple



Secondary colours are made by mixing primary colours together.



Pop Art



Andy Warhol was an American artist who was a leading figure in the visual art movement known as Pop Art. He is famous for his prints of Marilyn Monroe and of everyday objects.

Key knowledge to know and use

Pop art is a style of art based on simple, bold images of everyday items, such as soup cans, painted in bright colours.

Mixing colours together can create new colours. Mixing primary colours together will give secondary colours. White can be added to a colour to lighten it and black can be added to a colour to darken it.

There are different types of paint that can be used in artwork. They are all a little different to use.

Different size brushes will give different effects and will be used for painting different sizes of line and space.
