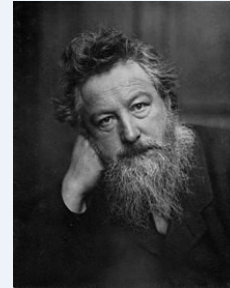

image	A visual representation of something.
impressed print	The printing block is created by carving out the surface.
manmade	Materials created by humans.
natural	Made from natural materials.
relief printing	Relief printing is when you carve into a printing block that you then use to press onto paper and make a print. The lines or shapes you carve into the printing block will not have ink on them, so will not show up on your paper.
techniques	A technique is a method of doing some task or performing something.

William Morris (24 March 1834 – 3 October 1896) was a British textile designer. He was a major contributor to the revival of traditional British textile arts and methods of production. He was inspired by the natural world in the creation of his designs.

Key knowledge to know and use

Artists use a range of materials and techniques to print designs. Relief printing is one example of a printing technique.

Artists use a techniques known as overprinting to add additional texture and colour to designs. Overprinting is when paint on a print is left to dry, and then printed on again.

Artists make sketches of the world around them to inspire the designs they create in their final artwork pieces.
