Key knowledge to know and use

St. James **Retail** Park is a £35 million retail development in the south of Sheffield. It covers 8.23 acres and includes a range of retail and food outlets.

Next door to the retail park is Graves Health and Sports Centre, which reopened in September 2016 after a £16m improvement programme.

The retail park and sports centre have had an **impact** on where people choose to visit and spend their money.


Local residents have raised concerns about increased traffic at Meadowhead roundabout as a result of many more people travelling to the retail

St. James' retail park stands on the site of the former Norton College which was demolished in 2017, having been disused for 2 years.







St. James' Retail park has created 250 new jobs and another 125 jobs during the building phase.
