

#### Key vocabulary to remember and use in your learning

| dynamics | The dynamics of a piece of music are the differences<br>in loudness between notes or sections of music. Dy-<br>namics can be written on a piece of music and tell<br>the musician how to play |

| ostinato | A phrase that keeps repeating itself. It often uses the same instruments and is played at the same pitch.   |
| rest     | A time of silence in a piece of music, marked by a<br>symbol showing us how long to take a pause. There<br>are different rest symbols, each telling us how long<br>the silence should last.   |

# <u>Composition</u>

Musical composition can mean an original piece of music, the structure of a musical piece, or the process of making a new piece of music. A composition is a piece of music (the word "composition" means "putting together", so a composition is something where music notes have been put together). When a composer writes a piece of music he or she is making a musical composition.

## Key knowledge to know and use

- Musical 'ingredients' have to come together when composing a piece of music.
- Ostinato is a repeating musical phrase and the rhythm behind it helps to keep it going.
- Knowing what you're doing when performing music lets you have total control over what is being played and how you present it to your audience.

### <u>Performance</u>

Musical performance is the time where musical ideas are shown and 'given' to a listener. In Western music, the performance is the best way to show that music is a type of art.
