Key knowledge to know and use

Our four seasons are spring, summer, autumn and winter.

Our days of sunlight are longest in the summer and shortest in the winter.

In the UK our weather includes sun clouds, rain, hail, snow, fog and wind.

The weather changes from hour to hour and day to day.

A weather forecast tells us what the weather will be in the next few days.
Weather forecasts help people prepare for different kinds of weather.

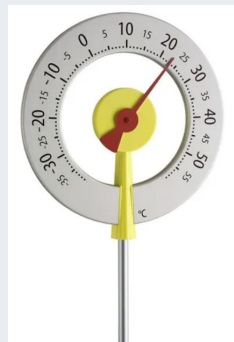
The weather forecast uses symbols to show different types of weather.

Some weather can be dangerous, for example, flooding and hurricanes.

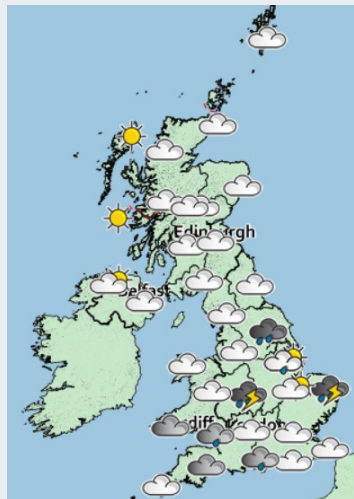
Word	Definition

thermometer	A thermometer measures temperature
flood	A flood happens when water covers land that is usually dry.



A thermometer measures the temperature of the air

A rain gauge measures how much rain has fallen.

A wind vane shows which way the wind is blowing.



Scientists study the weather and use computers to make forecasts.
A scientist who studies the weather is called a meteorologist.
