

History - Explorers

Year One has been investigating the famous Antarctic expedition led by British explorer Captain Robert Falcon Scott that began in 1911 and ended tragically in 1912. We learned how Scott and his team sailed aboard the ship Terra Nova, hoping to be the first in the world to reach the South Pole. Captain Scott's team was beaten to the Pole by Norwegian explorer Roald Amundsen and his men who were better prepared for the terribly cold conditions that, eventually, caused the deaths of Captain Scott and his brave companions.
