

During our trip to Magna, we really enjoyed learning all about all the different elements, including Fire, Earth, Air and Water. In these rooms, there was lots of tornados, even a fire one! We took part in a light workshop, where we used lots of cool lasers to experiment with light. We discovered that light travels in straight lines. The Big Melt was very interesting because all of a sudden, sparks flew out of the machine and there was lots of fire. Magna was our favourite day of Y3 so far!

Attendance

School attendance is a hugely important factor in children's academic, wellbeing and wider development. Evidence and research tells us that regular school attendance is key to improving children's longer term educational, economic and social outcomes. National data also suggests that children who perform best at the end of primary school (and secondary school) missed fewer school days than those who didn't perform as well.

This is also true of children who regularly arrive late for school. They miss the same parts of the day frequently which causes large gaps to form in their education, meaning that they will fall further behind their peers – both educationally and socially. Currently, there is a big push on school attendance, locally and nationally, and we want to also ensure that the attendance of all children at Abbey Lane is the best that it can be.
