




# RE Spring 1

## Year 3 – How do festivals and worship show what matters to a Muslim?



### Salah

One of the Five Pillars of Islam, this is when a Muslim will pray five times a day facing the Kaaba in Makkah.



### Zakah

One of the Five Pillars of Islam, this is when Muslims give money to charity. This is 2.5% of their wealth and helps the poorest people in society.

### Key knowledge to know and use

- The words Islam, Muslims and Salaam all share the same root SLM which means peace. Islam means to submit to Allah by trusting him with everything they have.
- To help Muslims to know what to do they will read the Qur'an which was given to Prophet Muhammad on the Night of Power.
- The belief in the oneness of Allah is called Tawhid.
- All of the five pillars show that a Muslim is submitting to Allah by doing what he wants them to do.

Prophet	<b>A messenger sent from Allah</b>
Muhammad	<b>The prophet who received Allah's message to the world</b>
Qur'an	<b>The Muslim holy book, for Muslims the final revelation from Allah</b>
Shahadah	The Muslim declaration of faith. It includes the beliefs that Allah is the only God and that Muhammad is Allah's messenger
Sawm	Fasting from food or liquids during daylight hours in the month of Ramadan, the fourth Pillar of Islam
Fasting	<b>Giving up food and drink for a religious observance</b>
